The Loyola Institute for Ministry (LIM) has a 50-year history of educating adults on six continents in practical theology—a method involving a rhythm of action and theological reflection. It has prepared them as leaders who announce the Gospel informed by a vision of the Christian tradition that emphasizes its transformative potential.

The BA includes a strong biblical and theological foundation, spiritual formation, and a core curriculum, commonly found in bachelor's programs. The program also includes the development of theologically sound and practical ministerial skills leading to professional competency. LIM emphasizes leadership and communication skills. It promotes a broad vision of ministry, which holds that it is practiced in explicitly ecclesial contexts—in churches, schools — and beyond, wherever people of faith live and work. At the end of the program, you will hold a degree from a well-respected Catholic university at a surprisingly affordable cost.




