Summary

The Coordinator of Middle School Evangelization & Formation, in collaboration with members of the Evangelization & Formation Team, will strategically plan, develop, and implement a vibrant evangelization and formation youth ministry program for students in grades 6 through 8. In collaboration with the Director of Youth & Young Adult Ministry (DYYAM), this position will include initial catechetical preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Develops, implements, and evaluates the middle-school youth-ministry program using a smallgroup process includes:
 - Develops a youth-ministry program focused on evangelization.
 - Able to share a lived experience of Christ with middle-school students.
 - A youth-ministry program for 6-8 grade students based on best evangelization & formation practices with middle-school students.
 - An engaging middle-school youth-ministry program with opportunities that include worship, retreats, fun, social, and service elements throughout the year.
- With the guidance of the DYYAM, implement initial catechetical preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- Collaborating with the DYYAM, coordinate Mercy Camp (middle school mission experience).
- Leads and inspires MSYM Adult Leaders in planning and executing ministry sessions, fellowship events, retreats, and service opportunities focused on evangelization and formation.
- Initiates the development of Middle School peer leadership.
- Collaborates with the evangelization/formation team to ensure a seamless transition between programs.

Other Duties and Responsibilities

- Adheres to parish and diocesan guidelines as outlined in the Employee Handbook and Safe Environment policies.
- Assists in developing the budget and practices gospel stewardship with funds.
- Handles confidential information with tact and discretion.
- Participates in staff meetings, gatherings, liturgies, staff retreat, and Franciscan events to build a culture of "evangelization through hospitality."
- Weekends and evening hours are required.
- Other duties as assigned.
