# Rural Health Scholars Program Overview

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- **Purpose:**
  - Encourage service in Louisiana's rural and underserved areas
- **Long-term goal:**
  - Expose scholars to rural healthcare work and, after graduation, assist them in acquiring a permanent job placement in a rural Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA)



# Eligible Students

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- **Students at Participating Colleges/Universities**
  - Third or fourth year students from a participating college/university
    - MD/DO Physicians (Family or General Practice, Internal Medicine, Obstetrics/Gynecology and Pediatrics)
    - DDS/DMD: General and Pediatric Dentistry
    - NP: Nurse Practitioner
    - PA: Physician Assistant
    - RDH: Registered Dental Hygienist
  - Goal of enrolling up to 15 students each year to participate in rotations



# Student Benefits

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- Opportunity to learn from rural healthcare professionals
- Exposure to potential career path
- \$6,000 stipend
- \$2,000 living expenses



# Student Requirements

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- Participation in a 2-hour seminar that will detail health disparities, discuss health equity, and provide information on chronic disease prevention efforts in rural Louisiana
- Submission of a white paper detailing their experience in the healthcare facility
- Participation in a pre- and post-program survey
- Must submit a service report at the end of rotation



- Will place three of each profession type.


