The Nurse Tech program at University Medical Center is designed for nursing students who have completed at least the first year of nursing school, including one clinical experience, and want a clinical experience beginning during the summer break with the possibility of extending throughout the year to provide insight, experience, and some education.

As part of the patient care team, while shadowing a registered nurse, you will assist in patient care during this program.
